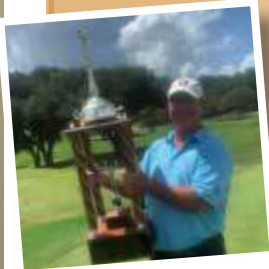

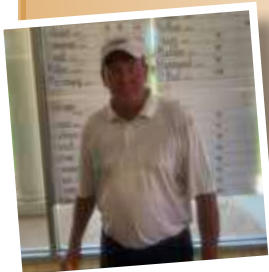

FROM THE GOLF COURSE SUPERINTENDENT

The greens have been in a continuous transition over the last three months starting with the improvement of the turf's health and then producing a smooth putting surface. The greens have been gaining in smoothness over the last eight weeks and would continue to do so but unfortunately, they must take a break and receive an aeration to ensure that we will have a healthy turf year-round. This is not a step backwards. We experienced a great improvement in the health of the greens after our first aeration in June and this final aeration on September 9th will continue our progress.

We'll be doing the same processes that we did in June but will change the order in which we do them. First the greens will be aerated with the deep tine machine that will create a channel 5-8 inches deep into the greens' profile that the turf's roots will follow, next we will aerate using a coring tine to remove some unwanted organic and we will be creating multiple channels through the dense layer produced by the turf. Performing this major aeration is vital for the health of the greens by creating the pore space needed to allow oxygen into the soil to grow a strong root system.

To aid in the recovery from the aeration we will skip the weekly growth regulator application and apply the necessary fertilizer and soil amendment to heal the greens as soon as possible. Once the greens heal, we will again switch our management practices to produce a high-quality putting surface.
